Update Guides

In this section of the documentation you will get all important information if you want to make a minor update.

The Release News provides you with an overview of the innovations in the individual versions of Shopware.

Updating Shopware

Only perform an update if you have gained appropriate experience, or contact your partner agency for support or update Shopware.

Create a test environment

We recommend that you create a test environment so that you can test a Shopware update in your environment in advance. You can find out exactly how to set this up here.

Secure your update

If you have not created a test environment, always create a backup so that you can easily resume operation in the event of problems! We also recommend that you always create a backup before updating the live system, even if this was previously checked in the test system.

Note that Shopware itself does not create backups. You should set these up separately on your server. If you have hosted your server with a hosting partner, they will usually take care of creating the backups. In case of doubt, you should contact the hosting partner.

Please note that the System requirements have changed, the system requirements for 6.5.0.0 can be found here.

Extension compatibility - IMPORTANT


Before updating, take care that all of your installed extensions are up-to-date and compatible with the new Shopware version, otherwise your shop may have problems at updating and you have to recover it from your backup. Whether or not your extensions are compatible can be checked in our Store, in the Auto-Updater in the admin or in your Shopware Account at *Licenses*.

Update by Browser

Shopware Installer

With the Shopware Installer you can install and update Shopware in a few steps. The same PHP file is needed for both. If the file is saved in an empty public directory and called, the installation process is started.

For an already existing Shopware installation, the update process will be started.




- **Step 1:** Download the PHP file from the download area (1).
- **Step 2:** Then move the file to the public folder of your Shopware installation.


In some FTP tools, such as Filezilla, it may be necessary to select the correct transfer type before uploading the file, otherwise the file may be corrupted. In the Filezilla example, select Transfer -> Transfer Type -> Binary

Step 3: Then open the file in your web browser:

www.my-url.com/shopware-installer.phar.php

The update will now start.






The update is done and you can access the administration.

Update per administration

Of course, you can also carry out an update directly via the administration. You will find the option under **Settings > System > Shopware Update**. In the window you will see your current version.


Step 1: Check system requirements



- (1) Before you start the update, the system requirements are checked again. If something is not in the green zone, you should definitely check your system for the required system requirements beforehand and adjust them if necessary.
- (2) Under Extension compatibility, you can find out whether your activated extensions will be available in the next version. One of the following three status messages will be displayed in your system after each extension during the update:
 - Already compatible Means that the installed version of the extension is already compatible with the new Shopware version.
 - With the new Shopware version Means that you have the option to update the extension to a compatible version after updating the store.
 - Not compatible Means that there is no successor version for this extension, and it will be incompatible with the new Shopware version.

Step 2: Deactivate extensions

The last step before installing the update requires you to check your extensions. Here, you should deactivate all incompatible extensions. Then you can install the update.



A Confirmation that you have created a backup is always necessary. Check **Yes, I have created a backup** if you have access to a current backup.

Install will then become active and you can start the update.

The form above will be displayed if Shopware detects incompatible or unverifiable extensions in your installation.

- **Deactivate all extensions** tries to deactivate all active extensions, regardless of whether they are compatible or not.
- **Deactivate incompatible extensions** causes the Shopware Updater to deactivate all extensions before the actual update that were previously displayed as incompatible.
- I am aware of the potential dangers, ... you hereby confirm that you wish to update without Shopware, deactivating any extension. If you choose this option, there is a risk that the update will be interrupted or that the shop can no longer be accessed after a successful update.

As a rule, it is sufficient to start the update with the recommended setting.

What options do I have if the automatic updater cannot deactivate all extensions?

If the update does not start, this can have various reasons. Therefore, the following points represent possible solutions that have already been successfully applied on several occasions.

- 1. Since by default only the incompatible extensions are deactivated, select Deactivate all extensions and then start the update again.
- 2. if you get the message that the automatic updater could not deactivate the extensions, try to deactivate the extensions manually under Extensions > My Extensions.
- 3. deactivating the extensions is also possible via the database. You can find detailed instructions here.
- 4. With a major update, for example from 6.4 to 6.5, it is necessary to deactivate all extensions. You can also use the instructions under 3. for this. With the SQL command for deactivation of the extensions, you then omit the WHERE part.

If you have used one of point 2.-4., do not select any of the options for deactivating the extensions in the form during the update.

Step 3: Install the update



If you have followed all the steps and installed the update, you will see the green ticks on the left side. Then you can complete the update successfully.

Update with Composer

This already applies from Shopware 6.3.0

Navigate in your shopware root directory. There, you can run the following command:

bin/console system:update:prepare

Open composer.json and replace shopware/core... with your wanted Shopware version like 6.4.18.0 Then you can start your update with the following command:

composer update

The versions of *shopware/administration*, *-storefront*, *elasticsearch* etc. must also be adapted for the desired Shopware version.

Run migrations with:

bin/console system:update:finish

To force-update all config files, run this command:

composer recipes:update

Avoid known issues

APP ENV=dev web profiler missing extension error:

Prior to Shopware 6.4.17.0, you have to install the Profiler bundle to get APP ENV=dev working with:

composer require --dev profiler

framework:demo-data is missing faker classes:

Prior to Shopware 6.4.17.0, you have to install some packages to get framework:demo-data command working:

composer require --dev mbezhanov/faker-provider-collection maltyxx/images-generator

Technical features

Performance optimization through lazy loading

The performance in the administration has been improved enormously in many areas. Measured against the new benchmark values, Shopware 6.5 performance has been optimized in the following areas compared to 6.4.

Dashboard	+ 227,03%
Product detail page	+ 234,38%
Settings	+ 232,43%
File size: CSS	+ 633,83%
File size: JS	+ 322,16%

Queue System

The new queue system is now completely based on the standards of the Symfony Messenger. This allows changes to the queue memory/system from now on. Furthermore, multiple channels can be used to optimize the resources of the queue worker.

The old queue system can still be used, so compatibility with external extensions is still guaranteed. More information about Symfony Messenger and the Queue can be found here in our Dev-Docs.


Features

New font in the administration

For better readability the font has been changed to Inter.

Improved rule management

Certain rule constellations within the Rule builder are not useful for all areas and therefore not applicable. When you configure a rule now, all conditions are always displayed. The conditions that are not applicable are now grayed out and marked.



New customer rules

More customer rules have been implemented as conditions. You can use them for example in the Rule Builder or in the Flow Builder.


The following conditions can be used: Affiliate code, Billing adress: State, Campaign code, Customer age, Customer created by admin, Customer is active, Days since last login and Shipping address: State.

Shipping to disabled countries

If a country is disabled for shipping, this notice is already displayed in the registration when selecting the country.

New address management

In the settings for countries you will find a new section to define the validation for the postal code.



You can choose between a standard validation and an advanced validation where you can enter your own regular expression.


Additionally there is a section to define the address format. You can add additional fields and separators and drag and drop them. The layout is used in the storefront, administration and documents when address information is displayed.

Flow Builder - Delayed flow actions

This feature is part of the Beyond Plan.

Here you get directly to the documentation of the new feature.


This feature allows you to trigger one or more actions after a certain period of time. Create flows from the Flow Builder with a time delay. For example, you can send automated mails two hours after an order.




The scheduled actions are displayed in the flow in a separate list. You can find more information here.

Return management

You can now create returns and partial returns directly from an order. Just call up an order and have a look at the items section. You can find more information about this under Return management.




When you select an item, you have the option to return the item (1) and set the status (2).



If you have created a return, the Returns tab is automatically created within the order. There you will find all important information about the return.

Tax provider

External tax services (TSP) can be connected. In countries like the USA, different and partly complex tax systems apply, which can only be mapped practicably by using external tax services. Under **Settings** > **Taxes** you will find the section **Tax Providers**.



There, the external tax providers are listed one below the other (1). Activate or deactivate the individual tax providers, set a priority or define a rule in the edit mode. The final tax calculation by the tax provider is always done only in the checkout of the customer.

Update Guide 6.4 to 6.5

System requirements

The basic system requirements for Shopware 6 can be found here.

Changes

For 6.5 the following versions are required:

- PHP 8.1 oder höher
- node-js Version 18
- Git

Extensions

To be able to update to Shopware 6.5, it is necessary to deactivate all extensions. Note also to set the theme to default and deactivate it under extensions.

Only with the extensions deactivated is the update to 6.5 possible.

Once on 6.5, the extensions can be updated and then reactivated.

Perform update

Vue 3 Support

The support for **Vue 3** is established and is used within the admin.

Some third party extemsions might interfere with Vue 3. The manufacturers are informed. It should be necassary to install an update of effected extensions.

Core Features

Faster storefront for an even better shopping experience


Shopware 6.6 brings improvements in loading times, which have two decisive advantages. On the one hand, store visitors experience a smoother and more pleasant shopping experience. Secondly, loading times play an important role as an official ranking factor for search engine optimization (SEO). Improved page speed can therefore lead to a higher ranking in search engine results and thus increase the visibility and reach of the online store.

The key aspects of this update include

- Faster store pages and SEO benefits
- Up to 6 x better indexing performance for multilingual stores
- Numerous technology upgrades, more security, robustness and compatibility
- Extended configurability for individual customizations
- Technical functionalities that were previously hidden behind feature flags
- Better expansion options for developers
- Paving the way for innovative features that will come with the next minor releases

Automatic Logout

The time for the automatic logout from the admin can be extended with an additional **Checkbox(1)** in the login page.



The login will be extended from several minutes up to 14 days.

New stock handling

The available stock is now recalculated when an order is placed. Before it was recalculated when the order was completed. Also, the stock handling can be deactivated within the settings.

Fixed path for media

The path for each media file is now stored in the database.

Before, the path was rendered for each load witch affected the frontend performance. It caused loading errors in the latest versions of 6.5.

Multilingual ES indexes when Elastic- or OpenSearch is used

The index of products and categories will be stored according to the used languages.

Boost in indexing for multilingual stores

In Shopware 6.6, we have taken a significant step towards optimizing search performance in multilingual online stores. By adapting the ElasticSearch mapping data to support multiple languages in a single index, store operators now experience significantly improved performance when updating and reindexing their product data.

Update Guide 6.5 to 6.6

System requirements

The basic system requirements for Shopware 6 can be found here.

If your version of Shopware is a 6.4, do an update from Version 6.4 to the newest version 6.5 first, before you start the update to version 6.6.

Changes

For 6.6 the following versions are required:

- PHP 8.2
- node-js Version 20
- >=MySQL 8 or >=Maria DB 10.11
- Git and access to our Git repository

Extensions

To be able to update to Shopware 6.6, it is necessary to deactivate **all** extensions. Note also to set the theme to default and deactivate it under extensions.

Only with the extensions deactivated the update from 6.5 to 6.6.

Once on 6.6, the extensions can be updated and then reactivated.

Perform update

Perform the update as described here in the administration.
